BASS Care offers a variety of Independent Living Units across four locations in Canterbury and Surrey Hills.

Accommodation varies from permanent self contained units to bed sit style units.

## Independent Living Units

### *Retirement living at realistic prices*

BASS Care units provide the perfect solution for those who wish to live independently within a supportive community. The self contained units are ideal for people who no longer want the burden of maintaining their own home yet do not need supervised care.

The units are affordable and very comfortable. Some of the key benefits include:

- ◆ A small private garden for most units
- ◆ Fully maintained grounds and units

## Bed Sit Accommodation

### *Affordable Long & Short-Stay Accommodation*

BASS Care Bed Sit units are self contained bed – sitting rooms with ensuite, kitchen and internal access to laundry facilities. They are located in an attractive garden setting with easy access to main roads and public transport. There is a large communal sitting room with an adjacent, well-equipped kitchen for the use of residents who wish to entertain.

Short stay rooms are low cost, convenient and ideal accommodation for a course, conference, medical appointment or holiday.

As with the BASS Care Units, access to other services such as Social Support and Community

Dining Room facilities may be available to eligible clients.

### Costs for Bed Sit Accommodation

- ◆ Short stay bed sit rooms attract a daily charge.
- ◆ Long stay bed sit rooms attract a monthly service charge, set in accordance with BASS Care's Schedule of Payments. An entry contribution fee is not required.

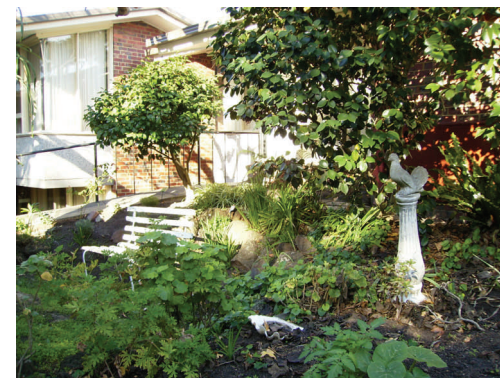
