

FALLS PREVENTION PROGRAM: COMMENCING IN AUGUST

We invite you to join our 'Falls Prevention' Group Exercise Program to lower your risk of falling, improve your strength, learn and socialise. Commencing in August & concluding in November 2018, this 15-week exercise program has been specifically designed to lower the risk of falls in older adults. The program involves a gradual progression of balance and strengthening exercises, supervised by our experienced exercise instructor. Participants complete a thorough initial and follow up assessment, with an allied health professional, as well as regular education sessions throughout the program.
