BASScare bus pick up areas include Kew, North Balwyn, Balwyn, Canterbury, Surrey Hills, Camberwell and Hawthorn. Our exercise class pick up covers a smaller geographical area. We collect from Camberwell, Canterbury, Surrey Hills, Balwyn, North Balwyn and Kew. Booking two days prior is essential.
