Deb is currently recruiting for new meals volunteers, should you know of anyone interested please encourage them to contact us.


Staying Connected - Zoom Catch Ups 2020

BASScare has introduced QR code check in at all sites. It is a Victorian state government requirement that we introduce this method of check in for their contact tracing purposes. The data is kept by Service Victoria and can only be accessed by DHHS. After 28 days the data is deleted. You will still need to sign in and answer the mandated DHHS questions in our paper register.
