What does Home Care look like?

The sole purpose of Home Care is to give you the power to live where you want to – in your own home. Safe, comfortable and happy. Our Packages are tailored to you, with the capacity to provide:

- **Services to keep you healthy and independent**, such as personal care, nursing services, meals at home and wellbeing services, such as podiatry.
- **Services to ensure your safety at home**, such as cleaning, home maintenance/modifications and assistive equipment.
- **Services that keep you in touch with the community**, including transport, social support and organised activities.



Find the right level of support for you

The Australian Government provides funding for four levels of Home Care support, each designed for different requirements, from basic needs through to high care. It's normal for most people to move through the levels over time.

BASScare can remain your service provider should your needs change.

What costs are involved?

There are two contributions that you may be asked to pay depending on your financial situation:

Basic Daily Care Fee – The basic daily fee is set by the government at a percentage of the single basic age pension. This fee varies depending on your Home Care Package level. This is an optional fee that may be added to your Home Care Package.

Income Tested Care Fee – The income tested care fee is an extra contribution that some people pay, as determined through an income assessment. This fee is different for everyone as it is based on your individual income, including your pension. Full pensioners do not pay an income tested care fee.



Package Fees

We incur some costs in providing your care and services. These are:

Care Management Fee – this fee is deducted from your package allocated funds.

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
