I'm sure, like us, you're itching to get back to face-to-face programs and this warmer weather is perfect motivation to resume many of the activities we love doing. As always, we will be ensuring that we provide you with a safe and welcoming environment so there are some important requirements for attendance that you need to be aware of...

In-line with the current State Government restrictions, all staff, volunteers and clients will need to be fully vaccinated to attend programs at the Canterbury and Marwal Community Centres.

When returning to the Canterbury or Marwal Centre for the first time, you will be asked to provide proof of vaccination to reception. If you prefer, you may email it to socialsupport@basscare.org.au prior to your first visit. With your permission, we will keep a record of your vaccination on your client record.

Proof of vaccination can be a digital or hardcopy of your immunisation history statement or COVID-19 digital certificate. If you don't already have your proof of vaccination it is available through MyGov and the Medicare mobile app. Your digital version on your smart device can then be linked to the Service Victoria app and will show each time you sign in using the QR codes at one of our sites.

Alternatively, you can request a hardcopy paper version from your place of vaccination, or by calling the Australian Immunisation Register on **1800 653 809.** *Please note* — *this can take up to* 14 days to arrive by mail.

Our staff and volunteers are happy to support and assist anyone who finds this process challenging please call reception on 9880 4709 if you need help.

We are excited to see you soon and appreciate your patience and understanding as we bring back your favorite programs and activities in a safe and supportive environment.
