Other fees that may apply:

Basic daily fee: A daily fee of \$65.55 is applicable to all residents (including those in respite care) regardless of which residence you choose. It is set by the Department of Health and Aged Care as a contribution to cover the costs of daily living. This fee will be reviewed on 20 March 2026.

Hotelling contribution and non-clinical care contribution: A fee individually calculated by Services Australia based on an assessment of your income and assets (not applicable to all people).

Retentions: Retentions will be deducted from the Paid RAD amount, calculated daily. The Retention calculation is based on 2% per year, up to a maximum of 5 years.
