We recognise the impact dementia can have on both the person and their family. We create welcoming places where calm is quietly felt. Through our group programs, one-to-one support from our Dementia Advisor and reassurance for carers, we bring together practical guidance with respect for independence and dignity.

We walk with each person, helping them feel more secure in the day-to-day and better prepared for whatever comes next.



Welcoming Places to Belong

Our Dementia Services programs are thoughtfully designed to spark connection, confidence and moments of joy. Guided by experienced staff and dedicated volunteers, each day is shaped around individual interests and abilities, creating space for people to feel seen, valued and at ease.

From gentle conversations and creative sessions to music, movement and shared laughter, our programs invite participants into a world where familiarity and discovery sit side by side. Specialised offerings support people at different stages of dementia, ensuring activities feel balanced, engaging and respectful.

Days unfold in safe, welcoming environments that feel warm and homelike, with nutritious meals and refreshments shared along the way. Structured group sessions and bus outings add variety and purpose, while flexible attendance makes it easy to join for a day or more.

Full-day programs run Monday to Friday, offering meaningful time for participants and a welcome pause for families and supporters.
